Concept – Test – Realization (2011-2014): Three-year educational and research project in the field of affordable architecture, in cooperation with the Bauhaus University Weimar, EiABC Addis Ababa and Juba University through funding by the DAAD. Three model constructions in scale 1:1 were collaborative designed and constructed by students and teachers in Ethiopia, in collaboration with the private sector.


